

## EUROPEAN BMX CHALLENGE CUP SERIE 2007 COMPETITION RULES 13 AND OVER

The UEC 2007 European BMX Challenge Cup will be raced in 4 male classes, 3 female classes and in 6 Cruiser classes composed in the following way

boys 13+14, boys 15+16, men 17-24, men 25-29 and 30 and over  
girls 13+14, girls 15+16, women 17 and older  
cruiser 13+14, cruiser 15+16, cruiser 17+18, cruiser 19-29, cruiser 30-39,  
cruiser 40 and older

The age determination in the above series will be according to the UCI age determination system. According to this system the age of a rider is determined by the age the rider will reach in that particular year.

boys 13+14, girls 13+14	are born	1994 and 1993
boys 15+16, girls 15+16	are born	1992 and 1991
men 17/24	are born	between 1990 and 1983
women 17 and over	are born	1990 and before
men 25/29	are born	between 1982 and 1978
men 30 +	are born	1977 and before
cruiser 13+14	are born	1994 and 1993
cruiser 15+16	are born	1992 and 1991
cruiser 17+18	are born	1990 and 1989
cruiser 19-29	are born	1988 and 1978
cruiser 30-39	are born	1977- 1968
cruiser 40 and older	are born	1967 and before

There is no woman cruiser class, should a girl wish to participate in cruiser class she will be integrated among the other cruiser male riders.

The UEC 2007 European BMX Challenge Cup will be run through a series of 10 rounds, listed on the UCI BMX international calendar 2007.

For determination of the overall standings, the results of best **6 rounds out of 10 will count. To be adopted in the final overall standings, riders must race 5 of 10 rounds.**

**Transfer system, seeding and starting position on the gate: same system as Championship classes**

The system of the number of riders to put into motos shall be as per UCI BMX Rule book effective from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007

A minimum of five riders constitute a class,

From round 2, motos shall be seeded according to riders ranking places in the newest list of overall standings of the UEC 2007 European BMX Challenge Cup.

Starting positions in the motos will be according to appendix 2 of the 2007 UCI BMX Rule Book. Starting positions in all qualifying rounds after the motos and in the main are determined according to the result of the previous races (free choice of riders when they come to the gate in the order of the printed moto sheet).

The entry fee is 25.00 € per round in all classes.

Late entry of riders at spot of event is possible in all rounds only by Chef d'equipe, and with the **agreement of the chief Referee and Chief Administrator.**

A penalty for late entries will be charged and the rider will have to pay double amount due if he register after the deadline.

**A federation (and only the federation)** can cancel riders until the thursday at 8 am before the event. They will not have to pay for this registration. If they do not show up at the event and do not cancel participation in due time, entry fee will have to be paid. Late entries of riders on the spot of the race event are possible in all rounds by the team manager in agreement with the chief referee and/ or the chief administrator.



Riders race with the following number plates and number colour combinations:

Boy's classes	white plate, black numbers,
Girl's classes	blue plate, white numbers,
Cruiser classes	red plate, white numbers.

They must also bear a lateral white plate with their black race number on both sides like in 2006.  
Size of numbers 80 mm high, 10 mm wide.

It is advised to wear flags on both shoulders or national shirt during the all rounds of the European Challenge Cup.  
For all other matters the 2007 UCI BMX rule book is applicable.

**POINTS TO BE AWARDED PER ROUND (IN ALL BOYS, GIRLS AND CRUISER CLASSES): SAME POINTS AND TRANSFER SYSTEM AS CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES**

In the case of an equal number of points in the overall standings, the rider with the most first places (and so on) in the main finals will be the winner.

In case of a rider being disqualified during a certain round of an event, he will not be awarded any series points for the round he was disqualified, but he will keep earlier gained points during that particular event.

#### **Awards at all classes**

In each round all finalists from place 1 to 3 will receive a trophy, finalists placed 4 to 8 will receive a trophy or medal.

The best 3 of each class in the final overall standings will receive a trophy or medals.

Awards for overall standing will be held up in Kampen (Nederland) on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> of June.
