



UEC 2007 EUROPEAN BMX CRUISER ELITE AND CRUISER JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

COMPETITION RULES

The **UEC 2007 European BMX Cruiser Junior and Elite Championships** will be raced as a part of the UEC 2007 European BMX Championships.

Cruiser Elite	19 years and older male riders
Cruiser Junior	17 and 18 years old male riders.
Elite Women Cruiser	19 years and older female riders
Junior Women Cruiser	17 and 18 years old female riders

The age determination will be according to the UCI age determination system. According to this system the age of a rider is determined by the age the rider will reach in that particular year.

Cruiser Elite	are born	1988 and before
Cruiser Junior	are born	1989 and 1990

TRANSFER SYSTEM FOR ALL QUALIFYING ROUNDS AFTER THE MOTOS AND FOR THE MAIN FINAL IS THE UCI RULE BOOK VALED THE NEWEST VERSION

In the case when there are less than 8 riders in a class, classification is made after the 3 motos.

In the case 9-16 riders (two moto) four top riders go to final. Exception by 9 riders the top three riders From 4 riders' moto and top 4 from 5 riders moto will transfer to the final.

Starting position in the motos is according UCI rule book 2007.

Starting position in all qualifying rounds after the motos and in the main final is determined by the riders free choice on the gate.

Each country is allowed to delegate an unlimited number of riders in Elite Cruiser (men and women), as well as in Junior Cruiser (men and women).

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee is 25.00€ per rider in both classes.

Late entry of riders at spot of event is possible in all rounds only by Chef d'equipe, and with the **agreement of the chief Referee and Chief Administrator**.

A penalty for late entries will be charged and the rider will have to pay double amount due if he register after the deadline.

A federation (and only the federation) can cancel riders until the thursday at 8 am before the event. They will not have to pay for this registration. If they do not show up at the event and do not cancel participation in due time, entry fee will have to be paid.

RACE NUMBERS

Riders will race with the following number plates and number colour combinations:

Red plate, white numbers

They must also bear a lateral white plate with their black race number on both sides like in 2006. Size of numbers 80 mm high, 10 mm wide.

All riders competing in the **UEC 2007 European BMX Cruiser Junior and Elite Championships** must have the national flag of their country on both shoulders : size on both shoulders at least 7X6 cm wide.

If this is not the case a rider will not be allowed to attend the race. The only exception is wearing the national shirt of their country.

AWARDS

All finalists from place 1 – 3 will receive the UEC European Championship Medal (Gold, Silver, Bronze), finalists on place 4-8 will receive a trophy.

The European Champion will receive the European Champion shirt.

For all other matters the 2007 UCI BMX rule book is applicable.
