UEC EUROPEAN BMX CHALLENGE 2009 COMPETITION RULES – FREDERICIA- DANMARK

The **UEC European BMX Challenge 2009** will be raced in 11 male classes, 9 female classes and 6 cruiser classes composed in the following way.

Boys **B9, B10, B11, B12, B13, B14, B15, B16, Men 17/24, Men 25/29, Men 30+ Challenger and 30+ Masters**
 Girls **G9, G10, G11, G12, G13, G14, G15, G16, Women 17 +**
 Cruiser **CR13/14, CR15/16, CR17/18, CR19/29, CR30/39, CR40- 44 and 45+.**

The age determination in the UEC European BMX Challenge 2009 will be according to the UCI age determination system.

TRANSFER SYSTEM, SEEDING AND STARTING POSITIONS ON THE GATE

We will use the same system as European championship

Starting positions in the motos shall be according to appendix 2 of the 2009 UCI BMX Rule Book. Starting positions in all qualifying rounds after the motos and in the main final shall be determined by riders free choice on the gate.

Each country is allowed to delegate a number of 16 riders in all race categories, for the host country it is allowed to delegate 32 riders in all race categories. In the 3 race classes of men 17/24 – 25/29, 30 + and 30+ Masters it is allowed to enter riders without any limitation.

The entry fee is 27.00 € per rider in all challenge classes.

Late entry of riders at spot of event is possible only by Chef d'équipe, and with the **agreement of the chief Referee and Chief Administrator.**

A penalty for late entries will be charged and the rider will have to pay double amount due if he register after the deadline.

A federation (and only the federation) can cancel riders until the thursday at 8 am before the event. They will not have to pay for this registration. If they do not show up at the event and do not cancel participation in due time, entry fee will have to be paid.

Riders will race with the following number plates and number colour combinations: According UCI Rules 2009.
For all classes 12 and under; clips pedals are NOT allowed at all European races 2009.

They must also bear a lateral white plate with their black race number on both sides like in 2008.
Size of numbers 80 mm high, 10 mm wide.

All riders competing in the **UEC European BMX Challenge 2009** must have the national flag of their country on both shoulders. Size on both shoulders must be at least 7X6 cm wide.

All riders in the **UEC European BMX Challenge 2009** must wear national flag of their country on both shoulders, otherwise they will NOT be allowed to attend the race. The only exception is to wear a national shirt of their country.

AWARDS (in all Boys-, Girls- and Cruiser Challenge classes)

In all race categories the finalists from place 1 to 8 will receive a trophy.

PRIZE CEREMONY

Only riders placed 1 to 3 go to the podium. Riders placed 4 to 8 receive the trophy or medal on the finish line.

For all other matters the 2009 UCI BMX rule book is applicable.
